

### **Major achievements in CSR by CIL and subsidiaries in past one year**

1. CIL has contributed Rs. 160.00 crores to Prime Minister Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Situations (PM-CARES) Fund for control and relief measures for COVID-19 pandemic. Subsequently, Rs. 61.04 cr. have been contributed to the fund from the salary of employees of CIL and subsidiaries. In addition, subsidiaries of CIL have been contributing in fighting the pandemic by distributing masks and sanitizers, providing financial assistance to district authorities and providing food and water to needy persons. Till 24<sup>th</sup> June 2020, 57,558 liters of sanitizer and more than 14.80 lakh masks have been distributed. In addition, 281272 cooked food packets and 135302 dry ration packets have been distributed till this date.
2. CIL has provided a financial assistance of Rs. 50.32 cr. to Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. (OTPCL) for restoration of power transmission lines damaged due to tropical cyclone Fani.
3. More than 130 transplants have been completed so far under CIL's scheme for treatment of Thalassemia by providing financial assistance to six major hospitals for Bone Marrow Transplants.
4. CIL has sanctioned Rs. 25.00 cr. for reconstruction of Govt. schools damaged in flood in Dharwad and Bagalkot districts of Karnataka.
5. MCL has completed Mahanadi Institute of Medical Sciences and Research (MIMSR) at Talcher, Odisha and the first batch of MBBS students are scheduled to be inducted soon.
6. CCL is installing solar units in 1500 homes in 5 villages under its Amrapali project at Chatra district, Jharkhand.
7. NCL has distributed smokeless smart stoves to 200 underprivileged families in Ajgud, Singrauli, Madhya Pradesh.
8. SECL has provided 128 slice CT scan machine and 3 Tesla MRI machine at Chattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chattisgarh.
9. BCCL has provided financial assistance for development of smart classes in a total of 129 schools in Dhanbad, Jharkhand.
10. ECL has entered into a contract to provide financial assistance to ITI, Sikitia, Godda for training of 216 persons in 5 trades for a period of ten years.
11. WCL has installed 25 sanitary napkin vending machines along with 1 year napkin stock in schools and slums of Nagpur, Maharashtra. The initiative has been named as Project Pankh.
12. CMPDIL is encouraging girl child education through its Beti Bachao Beti Padhao initiative by providing school uniform and text books in Birsa Uchha Vidyalaya, Ranchi.

13. Subsidiary companies of CIL are constructing prefabricated toilets at railway stations in their circulating areas. 529 toilet blocks are being constructed by SECL, 232 by MCL, 200 by CCL and financial support is being provided by CIL to ECL for construction of 100 toilets blocks.
14. CIL has been awarded the 'CSR winner award for rural development and infrastructure' at the 6<sup>th</sup> CSR Impact awards 2018-19 for its CSR project for holistic rural development works in Neturia block of Purulia district, West Bengal.
15. 2 subsidiaries of CIL have been conferred the prestigious National CSR award by Hon'ble President of India under the category – Contribution to national priority areas
  - a. CCL – For promotion of sports
  - b. MCL – For health, safe drinking water and sanitation

**Achievements in Skill Development by CIL and subsidiaries in the past one year**

1. More than 1904 persons have been trained through different centers of Central Institute of Plastic Engineering and technology (CIPET) with more than 80% placement.
2. CIL and subsidiaries have trained a total of 6597 persons in different trades as part of their skill development initiatives under CSR during past one year.
