Sub: Revised Rate of DA for the Contractor's Workers engaged in Mining Activities

The ministry of Labour & Employment vide order No. 1/2(2)/2014-LS-II dated 29/09/2014 revised the rates of Variable Dearness Allowance on the basis of Average Consumer Price Index No. for the preceding period of 06 months ending on 30.06.2014 reaching 241.00 from 202.83 (Nil) (Base 2001=100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 38.17 points for industrial workers. This order shall come in force w.e.f. 01.10.2014.

In terms of clause (b) of recommendation of High Power Committee, the rates of variable dearness allowance including rates of wages for contractor's workers engaged in mining activities as per the recommendation in which it is defined under section 2(h),(j) and (k) of Mines Act 1952 including washery, CHP and railway sidings. The basic rate of wages and VDA payable per day w.e.f. 01.10.2014 will be as under:-

Semi Skilled/ Unskilled Supervisory	29.00
Skilled	34.00

Therefore, the minimum rates of wages showing the basic rates and variable dearness allowance payable w.e.f. 01.10.2014 will be as under:-

Categories of employees	Rates of Wages including VDA (in Rs.) Per day w.e.f. 01.04.2014
Unskilled	<u>464.00+23.00</u> 487
Semi Skilled/ Unskilled Supervisory	<u>494.00+29.00</u> 523
Skilled	<u>524.00+34.00</u> 558
Highly SKilled	<u>554.00+40.00</u> 594

Other terms and conditions mentioned in the recommendations of the High Power Committee shall remain the same.

It is requested to take necessary action to implement the same.
