"VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK 2021"

Short Film making competition for Employees of CIL and all its Subsidiaries

- Topic of the Short Film: The topic will be the theme of this year "Independent India @ 75: Self Reliance with Integrity; स्वतंत्र भारत @ 75: सत्यिनष्ठा से आत्मिनिर्भरता".
- The entry deadline is 01.11.2021, 24:00 HRS to be sent to shortfilmvaw2020@gmail.com.
- > Conditions for Participating in Competition:
 - The Competition is open for all Employees of CIL including all subsidiaries. Each employee is allowed only one film entry.
 - This is a short film competition and hence ONLY Short Films should be submitted. The entries can also be digital animation films on the topic. The name and identity of the participant should nowhere be indicated on the movie. They will have to fill separate form and send long with the film in different file.
 - DURATION: The films shall not be more than 3 (Three) minutes (180 seconds) around 20-30 MB. Films exceeding this time limit are liable to be rejected. The minimum length should be 30 seconds.
 - The short films must be in English/Hindi or in any indian languages. However, for films made in regional languages, subtitles in English is mandatory. Films submitted previously to any other festival/copied from internet/social media will not be considered for this contest. If found later, will be disqualified for the contest/prize withheld. The work should be original in nature and the individual work of the participant. However, the participants are allowed to take ideas from books, journals, internet and the references must be given by the participants at the end of the video.
 - FORMAT: The films may be shot in MPEG4 or AVI format.
 - Restrictive requirements:
 - Contest works should not contain:
 - i. Texts, plots, actions of stage persons and characters from any political field, TV personality etc and should not attempt to outrage the modesty of any gender, religion, caste and community.
 - ii. Obscene words (abusive language), words and phrases degrading human dignity, strong expressions and slang, embedded advertising, demonstration of smoking, firearms and cold weapons, explosives, the process of making explosive devices, the use of alcohol and drugs, other psychotropic substances;
 - iii. Showing actual addresses and telephone numbers, information on religious movements, including religious symbols, names and references to existing brands of goods, trademarks, service marks, individuals and legal entities;

- iv. Images of fascist paraphernalia (swastika), scenes of violence, any kind of discrimination, vandalism, blood, reflecting the bodily suffering of people and animals, sexually explicit scenes, images of naked people, and other information, degrading in any form a person or a group of people, as well as information that may cause harm to health and (or) child development and containing calls for extremist activities.
- v. It is not allowed to use other people's texts, videos and audio materials (plagiarism), except for citing works to the extent permitted by the copyright law.
- vi. In case of non-compliance with these requirements, the work will be disqualified from participation in the Contest at any stage.
- vii. Contest works are not to be returned nor reviewed. Once submitted to Vigilance Division, it cannot be taken back for any changes.
 - Pendrive, CDs etc. will not be accepted. Only video through official email will be accepted. All communication or phone calls should be made only during office hours.
 - Each video will have to be submitted with a declaration form which includes the details of employee in a separate file. Once again it is to be reminded that Name, EIS etc. or any personal identity should not be disclosed in the video.
 - The entries of contest/ competition will be scrutinized and selected by the Panel of Judges selected by CVO, CIL.
 - There are three cash prizes in this category I- Rs.10,000, II-Rs.7,000, III- Rs. 5,000 and three consolation prizes of Rs.3000. One certificate of participation will be given combining all events.
 - The winners will be intimated personally and through the Contact NOs and Email IDs.
 - Once submitted to Vigilance Division, CIL the Essay/Speech/Painting/Short VIDEO will become property of Vigilance Division, CIL and can be used for in house publications and Exhibition.
